## November 2021

- **1-2** Pray for the approximately 8,220 speakers of the **Angoram** language who live in East Sepik Province. They have no Scripture in their language at this time.
- **3-4** Pray for clarity and fluency for five Urim readers as they record multiple New Testament books over the next three weeks in Wewak. Pray for good health and that all the equipment will function properly.
- **5-6** Pray for the approximately 3,600 speakers of the **Bungain** language who live in East Sepik Province. They have no written Scripture in their language yet.
- **7-8** Pray for wisdom and peace for **Andy** and **Christina Edmondson** as they have had to return to the US unexpectedly due to some unresolved health issues for Andy. Pray for healing for Andy and for God's guidance as they figure out what they should do next.
- **9-10** Pray for the approximately 360 speakers of the **Pasi** language who live in Sandaun Province. They have no Scripture in their language yet.
- **11-12** Pray for wisdom for the Aitape West Translation teams as they continue translating and checking during November as they prepare for the consultant checking workshop in January. Pray that the passages being translated would change their lives even as they do the translation.
- **13-14** Pray for the approximately 970 speakers of the **Sowanda** language who live in Sandaun Province. They have no Scripture in their language at this time.
- **15-16** Pray for discernment for government officials and medical staff as they continue to deal with the recent COVID surge throughout the country. It has been quite taxing on medical staff as they are stretched to their limits.

- **17-18** Pray for the approximately 960 speakers of the **Agi** language who live in Sandaun Province. They have no written Scripture in their language at this time.
- **19-20** Pray for wisdom and clarity for the SPES team as they look at schedules and available personnel for next year. The team has more opportunities than they can currently fulfill, so decisions will need to be made regarding how to prioritize events.
- **21-22** Pray for the approximately 200 speakers of the **Pefiyahe** language who live in East Sepik Province. They have no Scripture in their language at this time.
- Pray for boldness for Awtuw, Inebu One, Muno, and Southern One Oral Bible Translation (OBT) participants as they share their newly translated Bible stories, including some Christmas stories. Pray that these stories will make a difference in people's lives.
- **25-26** Pray for the approximately 300 speakers of the **Asaba** language who live in East Sepik Province. They have no Scripture in their language at this time.
- **27-28** Pray for strength for **Litz Liew** as she cares for her mother who is very sick in Taiwan. Pray for direction to know when is the right time to come back to PNG to continue her work with the **Keak** people.
- **29-30** Pray for the approximately 2,800 speakers of the **Ulau-Suain** language who live in Sandaun Province. They have no Scripture in their language at this time.
